## MSP GEOTRANS LINUX INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The distribution of GEOTRANS for Linux is packaged as a compressed tar archive named either *linux\_user.tgz* or *linux\_dev.tgz*. To install it:

**1.** Create a directory to contain the distribution:

% mkdir /home/geotrans

Note: You may replace /home/geotrans with your preferred install path.

2. Change your working directory to the directory you just created:

% cd /home/geotrans

**3.** Copy the archive from wherever it is located, to the GEOTRANS home directory:

% cp linux\_user.tgz /home/geotrans

**4.** Uncompress the archive using the Gnu unzip utility:

% gunzip linux\_user.tgz

5. Extract the contents of the tar file:

% tar xvf linux\_user.tar
