

MSP GEOTRANS LINUX INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The distribution of GEOTRANS for Linux is packaged as a compressed tar archive named either *linux_user.tgz* or *linux_dev.tgz*. To install it:

1. Create a directory to contain the distribution:

```
% mkdir /home/geotrans
```

Note: You may replace */home/geotrans* with your preferred install path.

2. Change your working directory to the directory you just created:

```
% cd /home/geotrans
```

3. Copy the archive from wherever it is located, to the GEOTRANS home directory:

```
% cp linux_user.tgz /home/geotrans
```

4. Uncompress the archive using the Gnu unzip utility:

```
% gunzip linux_user.tgz
```

5. Extract the contents of the tar file:

```
% tar xvf linux_user.tar
```
